

Dear Friends,

Kids Club House is gearing up for our Fall session and would like to relay our plans with consideration of opening safely during Covid 19 pandemic. We understand you may have questions and concerns. We have prepared this list that will hopefully help alleviate them.

1. Class sizes will be reduced.
2. We will create "pods" (or group of teachers and students). Each pod will not mix with other pods reducing amount of people connecting each day.
3. There will be a temperature check at arrival.
4. No adults will be permitted in the building and kids will be received at the door.
5. Communications with parents and teachers will be handled by phone, email, or remind.
6. Each child will have their own set of markers/ crayons/ playdoh that is not shared with others.
7. All items sent for lunch will be disposable.
8. An Emist has been purchased by our school which is a device that will allow us to mist and disinfect each room prior to another pod using the room. The disinfectant is "drinkable" and is proven to be extremely safe.
9. We will ask all families to communicate with us on any possible exposure to the virus.
10. We will ask for all persons attending the Kids Club House to be symptom free for 48 hours prior to returning after an illness.
11. Staff will wear face covering but students mask wearing is optional.
12. Hand washing will be done multiple times a day and parents are asked to have their child use hand sanitizer prior to arrival.
13. KCH will continually follow any new guidelines presented by the CDC.
14. In the event of another shut down or for those choosing not to attend in person, an online program will be offered and optional for families to participate in at a reduced tuition rate.
15. Our orientation will be done on Zoom for parents only and a video will be made for the kids to meet their teachers and see their classroom.

In order for us to maintain these new guidelines, we ask that you communicate to us any changes in your plans to attend in September. We also need to know if you are flexible in the day and time you are planning to attend so we can balance out our pods.

Bear with us as we navigate these new circumstances. We remain dedicated to offer a quality, fun education for your child.
